


Clearing a Film Jam (Wrap-Up)

The GBC4250 is designed to eliminate film wrapping around the black pull rollers. It may occur though, if the film is loaded improperly with the adhesive side contacting the rollers, or if the film exit path in the rear is blocked.

To clear a jam.

- immediately stop the laminator, and set the speed control at slow
- Depress the reverse switch while firmly pulling firm out the rear of the laminator. Continue pulling and the film until it unwinds completely from the
- rollers. At this point you wall be a momentary lightening of tension, followed by a strong politic the opposite direction.
- 3 Release the reverse switch, and run the faminator forward until all wrinkled film exits out the rear

NOTE: If film is wrapped around the policoffees and does not extend out the rear of the iaminator remove the top film supply roll, and put the film towards the front of the laminator whole pushing in the reverse switch.



REAR

REVERSE SWITCH: Reverses the black point rollers to help clear a tilm jam (wrap-up) within the laminator. The GBC4250 is designed to eliminate film jams, but one may occur if the film is loaded improperly with the adhesive side contacting the rollers, or if the film exit path in the rear of the laminator is blocked.

NOTE: Rollers reverse only while the switch is depressed. Switch should only be operated at a slow speed with the "RUN/STOP" switch in the "STOP" position.
