

#### **HS-2000-A INTRODUCTION**


The **HS-2000-A** is the lower unit of our 10 or 12-up business card slitter. It is designed to cut card stock with a 12-up format into 3 each 3-1/2"x8-1/2" pieces with a 1/4" trim on each side. It will accept piggyback the HS-2000-B, the HS-440, or the HS-442 card slitters which uses a 4-up format to complete the cut from 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" to the finished card size of 3-1/2"x2". Both upper and lower units are equipped with automatic feed and off register adjustments.


# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

(1) Remove pin from carrier tray and move to extended position.




(2) The feed gate is set at the factory. It is not necessary to adjust unless more than one card at atime is feeding through.


To adjust feed gate loosen mounting screws on feed gate. Insert a piece of 80lb cover stock under the gate. (see photo) with slight downward pressure on feed gate tighten screws. To test, turn machine on. Hold a piece of card stock between thumb and finger, feed into machine holding onto one end. If gate is set correctly machine should have firm steady pull on stock but not rub on feed roll "O" rings with stock removed. If gate is set too loose cards may not cut straight.




(3) To adjust end guide (C) for feed and paper stock take a 1/2" thickstack of cards, tap on flat surface until even. Insert between guides and adjust until card deck just moves freely. Too tight may affect feeding. Do not try to set up with a single card. Use a stack of cards at least 1/2" thick.




(4) To start feeding operation fan stack of cards top to rear (see photo) to conform to angle of feed gate.




(5) Insert stack of cards apprx. 1/2" thick, press firmly against the feed gate. Keep thumb on top of deck and slight inward pressure with index finger to ensure constant feeding. For best results run a stack about 1/2" thick and retrieve from bins before running another deck.




(6) Off register, when cards have been printed slightly off to the left or right of center, use the off register adjustment to compensate. Turn knob (D) clockwise or counter lockwise as necessary.



**HS-2000-A** with **HS-2000-B** installed completes the 10-up or 12-up format.




## With top unit in extended position.



The **HS-2000-B** (upper unit) utilizes the lower unit's trim bin, and should be operated in the closed position.

To empy, lower unit trim bin, remove card catcher and slide out rear of machine.

#### **DURING OPERATION**

Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts. Do not operate machine with slide cover or any guards removed.
